

**STUDENT MEDICATION**

Any student who is required to take prescribed medication during the regular school day or during school sponsored activities must comply with the following regulations:

1. Medication may be given by the school nurse and/or his or her designee upon written orders from a physician, and upon written request of a student's parent or guardian.

The physician's orders must detail the name of the drug, dosage, time interval the medication is to be taken, diagnosis and reason for giving.

2. Medication must be brought to school in a container labeled by the pharmacy or physician and stored in a secure, locked storage place in the nurse's office.

Non-prescription medication must be accompanied by a written request from the parents or guardian. The request must contain assurances that the student has suffered no previous ill effects from the use of medication. Medication must be left in the custody of the school nurse.

3. Parents or guardians must be responsible for transporting medications to and from school.
